Critical Care Transport Class

If you have 3 years' experience as an RN in a Critical Care Area (ER or ICU) or 3 years' as a Paramedic and are looking for a new challenge or wanting to expand your education, there will be a Critical Care Transport Class at KCEAA beginning August 17th, 2017 at 0900. Classes will be held every Thursday for a total of 20 weeks (not including the first day of class which is college registration). If you are up for the challenge and interested in attending please submit an application to me no later than July 15th, 2017 at 1600. Attendance price will be \$900.00 and must be paid by the first day of class. The price does include the book for the class (170\$ value). You should consider taking this class even if you do not wish to work on a CCT Ground or Aeromedical unit, it will boost your knowledge and help your patient care. You can get college credit for the class. I hope to hear from you soon!

- *You are required to have 3 years' experience in an ER or an ICU
- *You must have a current CPR (Healthcare provider) card.
- *you must provide proof of vaccination for: MMR, TDAP, Flu Vaccine, Hepatitis B series or Titer.
- *You must provide proof of negative TB test.
- *You will be required to have the annual Flu Vaccine to do clinical rotations.
